

## 1. Dialing Rules

From this section, new dialing rules may be created. Dialing rules allow to configure incoming and outgoing calls behavior, prefix replacements, CLI settings, etc.

The following information should be provided to create a new dialing rule:

- **Load Sample** – from this list predefined samples of dialing rules can be loaded. By selecting an item from this list, other required fields will be automatically populated from the sample.
- **Country**
- **Country Code**
- **Area Code**
- **Dial the area code as a part of the number**
- **Prefix for accessing the outside phone network**
- **Prefix for domestic calls, outside of your area**
- **International Dialing Prefix**
- **Emergency Numbers**
- **Exceptions**
- **National Exceptions**
- **Local Dialing Number Length**
- **Convert CLI for incoming calls into this dialing format** – when this checkbox is ticked, the CLI settings of the called extension will apply, see [CLI Management](#).
